July and August saw the staff at the Dispensary preparing for the next 12 months, developing new strategies that will further expand our reach.

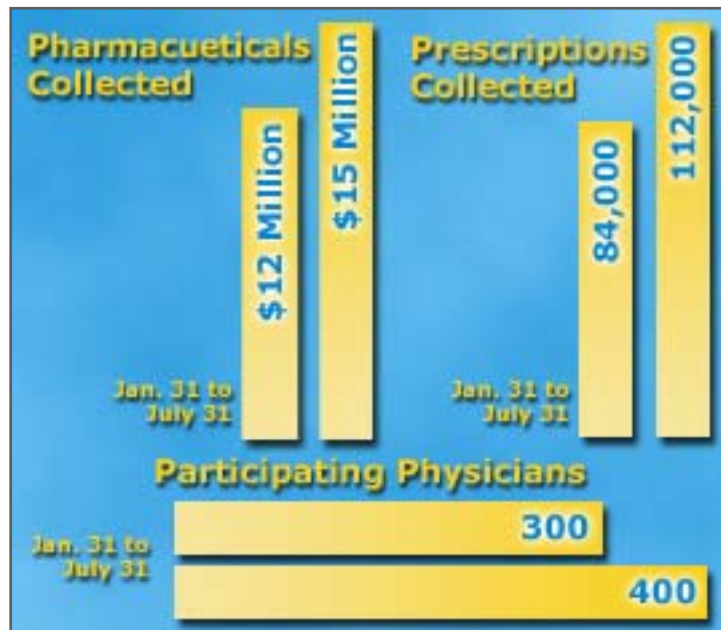
I want to commend our staff members in Nashville, Murfreesboro, Knoxville and Johnson City for all their hard work putting together the partnerships that make our network successful.

Dispensary of Hope Enters the Fall with Momentum

As the summer months wind to a close for the Dispensary of Hope, the steady growth of the not-for-profit network of dispensing sites, sourcing partners and financial partners continues its upward trend.

As of July 31, the Dispensary has collected more than \$15 million in pharmaceuticals and more than 112,000 prescriptions. The Dispensary has also added over 100 new physicians to the network that regularly donate sample medications.

Dispensary represented at 121st TPA Convention
